

2011-12 Employment Ontario Network Development Fund Funding Priorities

For the 2011-12 fiscal year the Employment Ontario Network Development Fund (EONDF) is targeted to support the development and full implementation of the Employment Service, Employment Ontario's foundational service transformation that is currently underway,

The EONDF supports such activities as:

- Provincial or regional stakeholder training and development opportunities
- The development of resources, tools and best practises

2011-12 EONDF funding priorities:

Access: Training in the development and/or use of transparent and measurable assessment/decision models that enable service providers to determine which of the ES service components individuals need to achieve program outcomes and standards.

Results Management: Training in the capacity of managers to use the OEOIS and other data in delivering high quality customer services and in meeting contractual commitments and performance standards.

Employment Placement: Developing the capacity of service providers to work effectively with employers in securing jobs in the "hidden job market" for individuals who require placement into work experience or on-the-job training placements, with and without subsidies.
