

## Employment Ontario Information System (EOIS) Case Management System (CaMS) Bulletin

### **EOIS-CaMS Release 6.1**

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide Employment Ontario service provider organizations with an update on EOIS-CaMS Release 6.1 and the related resources.

The ministry is pleased to announce that Release 6.1 of EOIS-CaMS was launched to all service providers and ministry staff on June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

The following items are the key enhancements introduced with EOIS-CaMS Release 6.1. For detailed instructions regarding the enhancements, service providers are encouraged to review the updated “EOIS-CaMS Service Provider User Guide” and “Detailed Reporting User Guides,” which will be published in the upcoming days.

#### **Employment Ontario Case**

Users are now able to select multiple Aboriginal Groups in the Client Self-Identification panel. The three available options are now: Inuit, First Nations and Métis (Aboriginal Ancestry no longer exists as an option).

#### **Literacy and Basic Skills (LBS) Service and Enhanced Learner Plans**

A number of changes have been made to these plans, including:

- The closure questions in the Enhanced Learner Plan have been aligned with those in the LBS Service Plan in order to support Canada-Ontario Job Fund Agreement reporting requirements.
- The Closure data fields in both the LBS Service Plan and the Enhanced Learner Plan have been reordered to improve clarity.

#### **EOIS Reports**

In Release 6.1, new case activity reports have been launched to support Youth Job Connection Summer (YJCS) and Youth Job Link (YJL): YJCS Case Activity Report (Report #121) and YJL Case Activity Report (Report #131). These reports capture case participant activity and expenditures for the fiscal year and include data filters based on report period start and end dates.

Several reports have been updated to support the “Aboriginal Group” enhancement in EOIS-CaMS:

- **ES:** Report 10, Report 11, and Report 15B
- **LBS:** Report 60B and Report 64
- **YJC:** Report 110B and Report 114

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A number of enhancements have been made to service coordination data, including the addition of referral in and out options, in the following reports:

### Data Files

New and updated Data Files have been included in Release 6.1. The “Data File Definitions User Guide” has been updated to include these changes. The new data files incorporated into the guide are as follows:

### Employment Ontario Self Service (EOSS)

EOSS functionality has transitioned to the “ontario.ca” website. The public will now submit a request to apply for EO programs and services through individual program pages. This transition has no effect on EOSS applications within EOIS-CaMS.

### Release 6.1 Resources

To support Release 6.1, the ministry is updating resources to aid service providers with the changes. The “EOIS-CaMS Service Provider User Guide” chapters, as well as the “Detailed Reporting User Guides” will be updated to incorporate the changes implemented by the new release. These chapters and guides will be available under the [“Guides and Resources”](#) section of EOIS-CaMS on the Employment Ontario Partners’ Gateway (EOPG).
