Youth Employment Fund

The Youth Employment Fund came to an end as of March 31, 2015 and is no longer a program available for participation by the youth or employers of Ontario.

What changes were made to EOSS/CaMS to support the end of this program?

Due to the ending of the YEF program it was decided that the path to youth services and their service providers would remain in EOSS as a targeted resource but the name of the program would be temporarily changed to "Employment programs for youth". This affects both the individual and employer paths. The selection of this targeted resource in EOSS by the user will continue to point them to the service providers who currently have YEF as an active service in the Case Management System (CaMS).

As of June 29 2015, service providers will no longer see 'YEF' type plan items in service plans. Existing YEF plan items will continue to exist and can be edited, but service providers will no longer have the ability to create new 'YEF' plan items.

When will this happen and how long will this be in effect?

The ability to create new plan items of type 'YEF' is scheduled to be removed in CaMS by June 29 2015.

The EOSS targeted resource titled 'Employment programs for youth' will be available until the fall.

What differences will Service Providers see?

In EOIS CaMS, service providers will no longer have the ability to create plan items of type 'YEF'. This option will no longer be available. Despite this change, existing YEF plan items will be allowed to continue and are editable by users.

There will be no changes to the Employment Service Case Activity Report #18 or the Employment Ontario Self Service Report #43 at this time. All existing YEF clients will continue to show on the report as 'YEF'. New applications for "Employment programs for youth" will also be counted as part of the YEF applications.
