

## Employment Ontario Information System (EOIS) Case Management System (CaMS) Bulletin

### **EOIS-CaMS Release 6.4**

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide Employment Ontario (EO) service provider organizations, with an informational update on EOIS-CaMS Release 6.4.

EOIS-CaMS Release 6.4 is expected to be launched on February 27, 2017 to all service providers and ministry staff.

### **What's Coming?**

Release 6.4 will include enhancements to system functionality, as well as new and updated reports. The following items are the key enhancements that will be introduced with this release. A more fulsome description of EOIS-CaMS Release 6.4 will be provided at launch in the "Go-Live" communique.

### **Literacy and Basic Skills (LBS) Service Plan**

Ability to differentiate between LBS service plans and LBS e-Channel service plans in CaMS.

### **Employment Ontario Self Service (EOSS)**

Pre-populate additional information from the application into the client's Employment Ontario Case.

### **EOIS Reports**

In Release 6.4, several reports will be updated to support the "Aboriginal Group" enhancement and the addition of wage columns to support the Job Fund Agreement. Also, new reports will be launched to support Youth Job Connection Summer (YJCS) and Youth Job Link (YJL).

### **Information Update**

Some employers have experienced an error when submitting their Canada-Ontario Job Grant (COJG) application. In many cases, the error message received upon submission is related to the manual entry of the date in the Declaration and Signature section, located on the last page of the application. In the interim, employers are instructed to use the calendar function in the Declaration and Signature section of the form. An updated form will be available in February/March 2017 that will address this issue.

### **Release 6.4 Resources**

To support Release 6.4, the ministry plans to develop and update resources to aid service providers with the changes. The "EOIS-CaMS Service Provider User Guide" chapters, as well as the "Detailed Reporting User Guides" will be updated to incorporate the changes implemented by the new release.
