

Employment Ontario Information System (EOIS) Case Management System (CaMS) Bulletin

EOIS-CaMS Release 7.0

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide Employment Ontario (EO) service provider organizations, with an informational update on EOIS-CaMS Release 7.0.

EOIS-CaMS Release 7.0 is expected to be launched on April 10, 2017 to all service providers and ministry staff.

What's Coming?

Release 7.0 will include enhancements to system functionality, as well as updated reports. The following items are the key enhancements that will be introduced with this release. A more fulsome description of EOIS-CaMS Release 7.0 will be provided at launch in the "Go-Live" communique.

Canada-Ontario Job Grant (COJG)

EOIS-CaMS and the COJG Employer Application form will be modified to support the COJG guideline changes as of April 1, 2017. Some of the new enhancements will include new Travel Costs fields on the Employer Service Plan Client Summary page and full funding up to \$15,000 for Unemployed New Hires where the employer has 50 or fewer employees.

Youth Job Connection (YJC) and Youth Job Connection Summer (YJCS)

A new Language Skills field will be added to the YJC and YJCS Client Summary page.

EOIS Reports

In Release 7.0, several reports will be updated to support the amended LBS reporting schedule, as well as and the COJG guideline changes such as new travel costs columns for New Hires and Incumbents. YJC and YJCS reports will also be updated to reflect a new Language Skills indicator.

Literacy and Basic Skills (LBS) Report Schedule Change

LBS monthly reports which currently run on the second Monday of the month will now be available on the first Monday of the month. The new report schedule will take effect on April 3, 2017.

The four LBS reports that will be affected by the schedule change are:

1. Report 60A – Literacy and Basic Skills - All Data – Information &Referral
2. Report 60B – Literacy and Basic Skills – All Data – Service Plan/Profile
3. Report 60D – Literacy and Basic Skills – All Data – Outcomes
4. Report 64 – Literacy and Basic Skills – Detailed Service Quality

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What does this mean to you?

To ensure a smooth transition into the new LBS report schedule, service providers **must** enter all Aggregate Data for March in EOIS-CaMS **no later than March 31, 2017**. This will ensure that Information Sessions, Participation and Wait List data is captured on the April 3rd reports for the new fiscal year.

As a reminder, all client service plan activities and service delivery site information should be updated in the system by March 31, 2017 to ensure that 2016/17 fiscal year end data is accurately reflected.

Data File Changes

A summary of the proposed changes to the service provider data files is now available on the [Guides and Resources](#) page, on the EOPG. Please forward this information to your technical/IT staff. These changes will be reflected in the “EOIS Data File Definitions Report Guide” at launch.

Release 7.0 Resources

To support Release 7.0, the ministry plans to develop and update resources to aid service providers with the changes. The “EOIS-CaMS Service Provider User Guide” chapters, as well as the “Detailed Reporting User Guides” will be updated to incorporate the changes implemented by the new release.
