

Employment Ontario Information System (EOIS) Case Management System (CaMS) Bulletin

EOIS-CaMS Release 18.1

The EOIS-CaMS release 18.1 is set to launch on April 6, 2018, to all service providers and ministry staff. Release 18.1 includes system enhancements and updated reports. Key enhancements and system changes are identified below:

Supported Employment (SE)

- A new service plan type will be launched to support the service providers in three communities delivering the first phase of the program.
- A new case activity report will be introduced to support SE.
- The Finance, Analysis and Systems Support Branch will be coordinating in-person training to the service providers who are new to the network and who will be delivering the first phase of SE to clients.

Canada-Ontario Job Grant (COJG)

- Changes to the employer and ministry contribution values and other program changes will be reflected in the WebForm and in EOIS-CaMS. Changes to the COJG WebForm will take effect on April 1, 2018, and EOIS-CaMS will be updated to reflect the changes shortly after.
- The auto-calculation function will be updated to reflect program changes.
- The COJG case activity reports will be updated to reflect all system changes.

Youth Job Connection/Youth Job Connection Summer (YJC/YJC-S)

- A number of client summary fields will be updated to align with policy changes. This includes the deletion of:
 - Socially Marginalized

- Language Skills
- And the addition of:
 - Lone Parent
 - Homeless and Housing
 - Hardship based on life circumstance
 - Leaving care of child welfare
 - Discrimination based on social identity
 - Mental Health.
- A new Job Trial plan item will be added to the Pre-Employment Service YJC sub-goal. A maximum of eight (8) hours within this PES-Job Trial plan item can be attributed to the 60-hour PES total.
- While YJC/YJC-S case activity reports will be updated to reflect these changes, the Detailed Service Quality Report data files and other reports will be suspended until a future release.

Release 18.1 Resources
