Ontario Employment Assistance Services (OEAS) Business Plans – Separation of Carry-Over and New Clients

Improvements are being made for the 2019-2020 OEAS Business Plans. Starting this business planning cycle, service providers will be able to breakout clients between new and carry-over in the Performance Commitments table.

New Character Counter Feature

A new character counter feature has been added to SP Connect. When completing a free text box, a new character counter will be displayed so users know how much space they have left. Users will see the new character counter feature when completing business plans, monitoring reports, and risk assessment deliverables.
