Dear Employment Ontario Service Provider,

I am writing to you today to advise that the Auditor General of Ontario will be conducting a 'value for money' audit of the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities Employment and Training Division's programs and services throughout 2016.

This process effectively began on December 1, 2015 when I met with the auditor and received the first request for information – work on this request is now underway. The auditor will be on-site in Toronto and will eventually be visiting other Employment and Training Division offices and potentially service providers throughout Ontario.

The Office of the Auditor General is an independent office of the Legislative Assembly of Ontario that conducts value-for-money and financial audits of the provincial government, its ministries and agencies. They also audit organizations in the broader public sector that receive provincial funding, such as hospitals, colleges and school boards. Their work helps ensure that taxpayers receive value for their tax dollars.

As a service provider that receives funding from the Employment and Training Division (ETD) of the Ministry of Training Colleges and Universities, your organization falls within the scope of this audit insofar as it applies to the ETD programs that you deliver on our behalf. As part of their review, the Auditor General's staff may contact you directly of information

Results of these value-for-money audits are published in the Auditor General's Annual Report.

As you can understand, these are early days in this process. As we move forward, we will have a clearer idea of what this audit entails and how it may affect your organization.
