## Particulars of Provincial Offences Conviction

<b>Description of Charge :</b>	<b>Conviction:</b>
During the period of December 7, 2011 to September 24, 2013 inclusive, being a person who was not registered to operate a private career college or to offer or provide vocational programs that require the approval of the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges, did, in the city of Toronto, or elsewhere in the province, offer or provide a vocational program for a fee contrary to s. 8(1) of the <i>Private Career Colleges Act, 2005</i> , S.O. 2005, Chapter 28 Schedule L, such contravention being an offence pursuant to s. 48(1) of the said Act.	On March 20, 2014, Joe SUM entered a guilty plea through counsel at the Ontario Court of Justice in the matter of Kingsway Driving School Inc. and Joe Sum. Mr. Sum pled guilty as a director to knowingly concurring in the offence committed by Kingsway Driving School Inc. namely, providing a vocational program for a fee, such contravention being an offence pursuant to subsection 8(1) of the Act.  An agreed statement of facts was read into the court record and a joint submission for a \$1,000 fine and 6 months probation was submitted to the court.  Mr. SUM was fined \$1,000 and was sentenced to 6 months probation.
