## **PARTICULARS OF A RESTRAINING ORDER**

*S. 49 (2) Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 ("Act")*

These particulars are posted following the issuance of a Restraining Order against an unregistered private career college by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges pursuant to s. 46 (1) of the Act.

### **Contraventions**

The Superintendent has ordered Armstrong Acting Studio Inc. operating as Armstrong Acting Studios to stop:

- Advertising an unregistered private career college and an unapproved vocational program, namely the AAS 5 Month Conservatory Program, that requires approval, in contravention of subsections 11 (1) and 11 (2) of the Act

### **Required Actions**

By November 27, 2012, Armstrong Acting Studio Inc. operating as Armstrong Acting Studios is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they:

- A. Have stopped advertising an unregistered private career college and an unapproved vocational program that requires approval, in contravention of subsections 11 (1) and 11 (2) of the Act

**Note:** Nothing in this Order prevents the School from providing non-vocational acting programs.
