NOTICE OF PARTICULARS OF A PROPOSAL TO REFUSE RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION

Reasons for Decision

The School has an extraordinary history of repeated non-compliance with the Act and regulations, including being previously proposed for revocation. The 2009 Minutes of Settlement that ended the previous proposal have been violated by the School. In addition, there have been further contraventions of the Act. Finally, the School is now seriously financially constrained.

In light of the preceding history and as a result of current evidence, I am proposing to refuse to renew the School's registration for the following reasons:

- I am no longer satisfied that having regard to the School's financial position, it can be expected to be financially responsible in the operation of the PCC (s. 18(2)(a) read with s. 14(1)(d) of the Act);
- I am no longer satisfied that the vocational programs provided meet the requirements of the Act and regulations (s. 18(2)(a) read with s. 14(1)(b) of the Act);
- I am no longer satisfied that the School will operate the PCC in accordance with the Act and regulations (s. 18(2)(a) read with s. 14(1)(b) of the Act);
- I am no longer satisfied that the past conduct of the School's officers and directors provides grounds for the belief that the PCC will be operated in accordance with the law and with integrity and honesty (s. 18(2)(a) read with s. 14(1)(e) of the Act);

- I am no longer satisfied that the School is not carrying on activities that are in contravention of the Act or regulations (s. 18(2)(a) read with s. 14(1)(f) of the Act);

Disposition of Appeal

On October 28, 2010 the School filed an appeal of this proposal with the License Appeal Tribunal. On May 14, 2012 it withdrew its appeal.

On August 17, 2012 the Superintendent carried out the proposal, at which time the School ceased to be a registered Private Career College.

Please note that this Order does not prohibit the operation of Cyprus Spa located at the same address.
