These particulars are posted following the issuance of a Compliance Order against a registered private career college by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges pursuant to s. 46 (2) of the Act.

Contraventions

The Superintendent has ordered CJ Trading International Inc. operating as Victoria International College to:

- Stop delivering its approved vocational programs with substantial differences compared to how they were approved; and
- Stop making false or misleading statements for the purpose of inducing a student or prospective student to enrol in a program or enter into a contract.

Required Actions

By February 14, 2012, CJ Trading International Inc. operating as Victoria International College is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they have:

- A. Stopped delivering its approved programs with substantial differences compared to how they were approved; and
- B. Stopped making false or misleading statements for the purpose of inducing a student or prospective student to enrol in a program or enter into a contract.
