These particulars are posted following the issuance of a Restraining Order against an unregistered private career college by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges pursuant to s. 46 (1) of the Act.

Contraventions

The Superintendent has ordered CLLC – Canadian Language Learning College Inc. operating as CLLC - Canadian Language Training College and also known as CLLC to stop:

- Advertising an unregistered private career college and an unapproved vocational program that requires approval, in contravention of subsections 11(1) & 11 (2) of the Act.

Required Actions

By April 1, 2013, CLLC – Canadian Language Learning College Inc. operating as CLLC - Canadian Language Training College and also known as CLLC is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they:

- A. Have stopped advertising an unregistered private career college and an unapproved vocational program that requires approval, in contravention of subsections 11 (1) & 11 (2) of the Act.

Note: Nothing in this Order prevents the School from providing non-vocational programs.
