Particulars of a Restraining Order

S. 49 (2) Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 ("Act")

March 22, 2013

These particulars are posted following the issuance of a Restraining Order against an unregistered private career college by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges pursuant to s. 46 (1) of the Act.

Contraventions

The Superintendent has ordered CanPacific College of Business & English Inc. to stop:

- Operating an unregistered private career college, in contravention of section 7 of the Act;
- Providing unapproved vocational programs that require approval, in contravention of section 8 of the Act;
- Charging fees, in contravention of section 9 of the Act;
- Advertising an unregistered private career college and unapproved vocational programs that require approval, in contravention of subsections 11 (1) & (2) of the Act.

Required Actions

By March 21, 2013, CanPacific College of Business & English Inc. is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they:

- Have stopped operating a private career college without being registered, in contravention of section 7 of the Act;
- Have stopped providing an unapproved vocational program (Executive Assistant Certificate program) that requires approval, in contravention of section 8 of the Act;
- Have stopped charging fees, in contravention of section 9 of the Act;
- Have stopped advertising an unregistered private career college and an unapproved vocational program that requires approval, in contravention of subsections 11(1) & 11(2) of the Act.

Note: Nothing in this Order prevents the School from providing non-vocational programs to the public.
