This is a **Restraining Order** issued under the authority of section 46 of the Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 (PCCA, 2005). As the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges, I HEREBY ORDER English School of Canada Inc. (English School of Canada) TO STOP OPERATING IN CONTRAVENTION OF THE PRIVATE CAREER COLLEGES ACT, 2005 (PCCA, 2005).

The detailed reasons supporting my order are set out in Schedule A, attached. In brief, English School of Canada is:

- advertising an unregistered private career college and advertising unapproved vocational programs, contrary to sections 11(1) and (2) of the PCCA, 2005, respectively.
- in contravention of s.46 of the PCCA, 2005 for refusing to comply with an order of the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges.

English School of Canada must provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the school, together with all available supporting evidence, that the steps outlined below have been taken. This written confirmation must be delivered **immediately** by registered mail or courier to my attention and confirm that English School of Canada:

- has stopped advertising an unregistered Private Career College and unapproved vocational programs that require approval.
- Has complied with the order issued on September 3, 2009 which stated “English School of Canada must stop operating a private career college” and “has stopped advertising unapproved vocational programs”.

If English School of Canada is currently providing unapproved vocational programs as an unregistered Private Career College, these actions would be contrary to sections 7 and 8 of the PCCA, 2005 respectively. English School of Canada would then be required to **immediately** take the steps outlined below in this order to comply with the PCCA, 2005.

Specifically, English School of Canada:

- must stop operating an unregistered Private Career College;
- must stop providing unapproved vocational programs that require approval;
- must stop enrolling students into unapproved vocational programs that require approval;
- must provide the ministry with a list including the names and addresses of all current and former students;
- must provide refunds to students who were enrolled in unapproved vocational programs that require approval;
- must not hold, directly or indirectly, any monies owing to current, former, or prospective students of unapproved vocational programs that require approval;
- must hold student files to be available for the Superintendent’s staff to review; and
- must not reopen as a Private Career College until such time, if any, as it has been registered.

### **Consequences of Failure to Comply with this Order**

Failure to comply with this order may result in any or all of the following actions by the Superintendent:

1. Application for a court order from the Superior Court of Justice to English School of Canada to comply;
2. The issuance of further Administrative Monetary Penalties;
3. Prosecution for offences under the Act. Upon conviction by a court of that offence, a corporation is subject to a fine of up to \$100,000; an individual, including an officer or director of a corporation who concurs in the commission of the offence, is subject to a fine of up to \$25,000, a prison term of up to one year, or both.

### **Obtaining a Copy of the PCCA, 2005**

## Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL)

The TESOL Program prepares students for a career in English language teaching – covering methodology, theory and practice. You will improve your command of English grammar and learn everything from effective teaching techniques to classroom management skills; needs assessment to lesson planning and more. There is an optional Practicum at the end of the program for hands-on experience in the classroom. This teacher training program is recognized by TESL Canada.

The PDF of the English School of Canada 2010 Tuition Fees found on the website April 29, 2010 states that the TESOL program is 8 weeks at 30 hours a week. The fee for the program is \$2,820.00. The webpage (<http://esc.iplex.ca/tuition.php>) itself states that the program is 8 weeks at 30 hours a week with a fee of \$2,820.00. Both descriptions fit the *PCCA, 2005* criteria of a vocational program which requires approval by the Superintendent. The website also suggests that these programs are

being currently offered because the Program Starting Dates list 13 start dates for the TESOL/TYEC program ranging from Dec. 28, 2009 to November 29, 2010.

On September 3, 2009, English School of Canada was issued a Restraining Order which ordered English School of Canada to stop advertising unapproved vocational programs. The Restraining Order clearly provided evidence that the TESOL program being offered by the school met the *PCCA, 2005* criteria of a vocational program which requires approval by the Superintendent.

Therefore, English School of Canada is contravening the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* by advertising an unapproved vocational program and thereby advertising itself as a Private Career College.

**Contravention of s. 46 of the PCCA, 2005 – Refusal to comply with an order of the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges**

On September 3, 2009, English School of Canada was issued a Restraining Order signed by the Superintendent which stated that:

*English School of Canada must also provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the school, together with all available supporting evidence, that the steps outlined below have been taken. This written confirmation must be delivered by registered mail or courier to my attention by **September 18, 2009**.*

*English School of Canada:*

- 1. has stopped operating as a private career college;*
- 2. has stopped advertising unapproved vocational programs;*
- 3. has stopped enrolling students in unapproved vocational programs;*
- 4. has attached a list including the names and addresses of all current students enrolled in unapproved vocational programs;*
- 5. is holding student files and will make them available for the Superintendent's staff to review if need be; and*
- 6. a) will not continue offering unapproved vocational programs, OR  
b) will not continue offering unapproved vocational programs until and unless it is properly registered as a private career college and has obtained approval for all vocational programs as required under the PCCA, 2005.*

As of April 29, 2010, the website (<http://esc.iplex.ca/>) belonging to English School of Canada provides evidence that the school has not complied with the order. The website advertises fees and start dates for a TESOL program which fits the criteria of a vocational program requiring approval from the superintendent. In addition, a full colour brochure on the website also advertises the TESOL program. Currently, the English School of Canada does not have the approval of the Superintendent to offer vocational programs and therefore is in contravention of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* by failing to comply with an order of the Superintendent made under s. 46 of the Act.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On August 31, 2009, Ministry staff attended English School of Canada, 79 St. Clair Avenue East, Suite 202, Toronto, ON M4T 1M6 and advised Mr. Stille to stop offering the TESOL program. On September 3, 2009 a Restraining Order was sent to English School of Canada to further advise them that the TESOL program could not be offered until the school had registered as an approved Private Career College. On September 23, 2009, Ministry staff attended the school once more and further advised the school to remove advertising pertinent to the TESOL program. At the time, the school had been granted an extension on the time period for them to come into compliance. The school then did fulfill their obligation to register by October 2, 2009 and sent proof of a bond.

However on April 29, 2010, when Ministry staff checked the website (<http://esc.iplex.ca/>) as part of the process of reviewing the school's registration package, the school was found to be still advertising the TESOL program.
