S. 49 (2) Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 ("Act")

These particulars are posted following the issuance of a Restraining Order against an unregistered private career college by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges pursuant to s. 46(1) of the Act.

Contraventions

The Superintendent has ordered 2207491 Ontario Inc. operating as Global ERP Solutions ("Global ERP Solutions") to stop:

- Advertising unapproved vocational programs, contrary to s. 11 of the Act;
- Providing unapproved vocational programs, contrary to s. 8(1) of the Act;
- Collecting fees from students without first becoming a registered private career college and having your vocational programs approved, contrary to s. 9 of the Act; and
- Operating an unregistered private career college, contrary to s. 7 of the Act.

Required Actions

By January 6, 2012 Global ERP Solutions is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they:

- A. Have stopped advertising unapproved vocational programs;
- B. Have stopped providing unapproved vocational programs;
- C. Have stopped charging fees for unapproved vocational programs; and
- D. Have stopped operating an unregistered private career college.

Note: Nothing in this Order prevents Global ERP Solutions from providing non-vocational programs or consulting services.
