**Re: Refusal to Renew Registration under the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* (the "Act")  
New Oriental Career Training Inc. o/a New Oriental College of  
Business and Technology (PCC ID# 102258)**

**I am writing to advise you of my decision pursuant to section 18 of the Act to refuse to renew New Oriental College of Business and Technology's registration as a private career college for 2007/2008.**

My decision and the facts in support of that decision are set out on the following page.

You have the right to appeal this decision to the Licence Appeal Tribunal (LAT). Information regarding this option is attached as Schedule A to this letter. If you wish to exercise this right, you must file your appeal with the LAT and serve it on this office by March 11 2008

**Grounds for Refusal to Renew Registration**

I have decided to refuse to renew New Oriental College of Business and Technology registration pursuant to subsection 18(2) of the Act on the grounds that:

New Oriental College of Business and Technology has had no students enrolled in any vocational programs at the private career college for the past two successive periods of the college's registration under this Act. The evidence of non enrolment is as follows:

- January 30 2006, New Oriental College of Business and Technology reported zero enrolment for the fiscal year 2005/2006.
- August 1 2006, an inspection was conducted by a Program Consultant. At this time it was reported that New Oriental College of Business and Technology had zero enrolments; however, it was expected that students would be enrolled by December 2006.
- As of December 31 2006, New Oriental College of Business and Technology reported zero enrolment for the 2006 calendar year.
- December 21 2007, New Oriental College of Business and Technology reported zero enrolment for the year 2006/2007

Given the facts set out above, and pursuant to my authority under subsection 18(2) of the Act, I have determined that New Oriental College of Business and Technology is in breach of its obligations under the Act and regulations such that its registration will not be renewed.

Please note that this decision to refuse renewal under the Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 does not affect New Oriental International College's status as a private inspected school with the Ministry of Education for secondary school courses offered.
