PARTICULARS OF A SECOND RESTRAINING ORDER

S. 49 (2) Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 ("Act")

December 21, 2012

These particulars are posted following the issuance of a Restraining Order against an unregistered private career college by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges pursuant to s. 46 (1) of the Act. A previous Restraining Order was issued on January 14, 2010.

Contraventions

The Superintendent has once again ordered Oxford Seminars International Inc. operating as Oxford Seminars to stop:

- Advertising an unregistered private career college and an unapproved vocational program that requires approval, in contravention of subsections 11 (1) & 11 (2) of the Act.

Required Actions

By December 27, 2012, Oxford Seminars International Inc. operating as Oxford Seminars is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they:

- A. Have stopped advertising an unregistered private career college and an unapproved vocational program, namely the TESOL/TESL Certification Course, that requires approval, in contravention of subsections 11 (1) & 11 (2) of the Act.
