

Particulars of Notice of Contravention and Review Decision
S. 49(1) *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005*

These particulars are posted following the issuance of an administrative penalty for which a review was requested. Penalties may be reviewed upon request within 15 days of receipt of a Notice of Contravention. The review decision is made considering not only the information originally available at the time the Notice of Contravention was issued, but also any new information not previously available that may have been supplied in support of the request for a review. On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

<p>PCCA, 2005 s. 11 - Restrictions on advertising and soliciting.</p> <p>On April 13, 2010, an online classified ad belonging to Stik-Man Logistics was reviewed by a Designate who found it advertising a Transport Driver Training course and a contact number. On the same day the Designate phoned and spoke with Pete Mosher who advised offering an AZ course of 45 hours in duration and a cost of \$3,500, with \$2,000 due at the time of the first lesson. Mr. Mosher also advised that the training is held at the location of Stik-Man logistics in Kitchener, Ontario, and that there is "...minimal classroom instruction." This course corresponds to National Occupational Classification (NOC) code 7411 – Other Truck Drivers, and is thus a vocational program within the meaning of the <i>Private Career Colleges Act, 2005</i> and is required to be approved by the Superintendent pursuant to section 23 of the Act. Since this college is not registered, and this program is not approved, advertising them is prohibited in accordance with section 11 as noted above.</p>	<p>\$1,000 per day</p>	<p>Penalty is reduced to \$500 per day for the period of May 7, 2010 to May 10, 2010 (inclusive).</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates that Stik-Man Logistics 05 Inc. was advertising an unregistered private career college and unapproved vocational program. Stik-Man Logistics 05 Inc. came into compliance on May 10, 2010 by discontinuing all advertising of an unregistered private career college and unapproved vocational program.</p>
