Particulars of Notice of Contravention and Review Decision

S. 49(1) *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* ("Act")

These particulars are posted following the issuance of an administrative penalty for which a review was requested. Penalties may be reviewed upon request within 15 days of receipt of a Notice of Contravention. The review decision is made considering not only the information originally available at the time the Notice of Contravention was issued, but also any new information not previously available that may have been supplied in support of the request for a review. On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

<p>Act, s. 11 – Restrictions on advertising and soliciting</p> <p>On January 9, 2012, a Designate of the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges ("Designate") examined the School's website (http://www.traintheguides.com/index.html) and observed that the School was advertising itself as an unregistered private career college ("PCC").</p> <p>The School was also advertising an unapproved Professional Tour Manager program on its website which was 5 days of training in class, totalling 35 hours in duration, plus an additional 2 days of mandatory field study, adding an additional 5 hours of duration, thereby placing the program over the 40 hours threshold under the Act. The unapproved program cost \$1,600 plus H.S.T.</p> <p>This School is not a registered PCC and has not obtained the approval of the Superintendent to offer this unapproved program and was therefore found in contravention of s. 11(1) and (2) of the Act.</p>	<p>\$1,000</p>	<p>Penalty of \$1000 per day was upheld for March 21, 2012 to March 21, 2012 (inclusive).</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates that The Tour Guide Training Corporation of Canada was advertising an unapproved vocational program.</p>
